Children at Mass

Children in Mass are gifts, not distractions! But if a young child does become disruptive, which is natural, please be respectful of other parishioners and remove the child from church and feel free to return once it is appropriate. Please do not let young children wander from the pew or run up and down aisles or disturb others. Also, if late for Mass, please do not proceed to the front of the church but instead occupy a pew closer to the rear. Consideration of others & reverence help to maintain a prayerful atmosphere for all.

Parking

Please, there is **no parking allowed in front of the church.** The spaces in front of the church are for busses and emergency vehicles ONLY.

Basilica Weddings

You must be an active, registered parishioner to marry at the Basilica of St. John the Evangelist. The bride or the groom must be a practicing Catholic and registered at the Basilica for one year before contacting us regarding scheduling the wedding here. One must be an active parishioner, regularly attending Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and using our online giving portal or the envelope system in regular support of the parish.

TE DEUM AND BENEDICTION SUNDAY, DECEMBER 31ST AT 6:00 PM

There are many traditions associated with this time of the year. One of the lesser known is the singing of the "Te Deum" a hymn of thanksgiving sung for special occasions. It is the custom to sing the "Te Deum" on New Year's Eve to offer thanks to God for the graces given during the previous year.

The Church offers a plenary indulgence to those who participate in this devotion under the usual conditions. (Sacramental Confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father within 8 days of the devotion.)

This year our choir will sing the "Te Deum" followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 6:00pm on New Year's Eve.


