### Dear Friends in Christ,



On Monday we will learn about the patron of the Diocese of Bridgeport, Saint Augustine of Hippo and read some of his autobiography "The Confessions". I hope you will join us in the Rectory Ballroom at 7:30 in the evening and make this series part of your celebration of Lent.
