With the Christmas season behind us, we begin to look forward to a new year! As usual, we have many things planned. Last year's Basilica Lecture Series was well attended with many wishing to continue with exploring the lives and spiritualities of different saints. Beginning in February, we will have three lectures in the Rectory Ballroom focusing on Saint Catherine of Siena, Saint Augustine of Hippo and Saint Philip Neri. More details will be published in the bulletin soon.

The Basilica Young Adults group (for ages 21-35) will resume their monthly meetings on Monday, February 12th at 7:30 PM. We begin in the Church with Eucharistic Adoration and a short homily, then move to the Rectory for a catechetical talk and refreshments. Join us!

This year, Bishop Caggiano is focusing on a Eucharistic revival throughout the Diocese to help us all have a deeper understanding and appreciation of the presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. We will participate in the Eucharistic celebrations planned in the Diocese with a procession of the Blessed Sacrament with Bishop Caggiano on Tuesday, May 21st. One must be an active parishioner, regularly attending Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and using our online giving portal or the envelope system in regular support of the parish.
