Dear Friends in Christ,

On February 2nd, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This feast occurs 40 days after Christmas and connects Christmas and the Easter Season. The Infant is being presented in the temple by Mary and Joseph, but Simeon foretells the future suffering of the Child and tells Our Lady that her own heart will be pierced.

Simeon also calls the Christ Child the "Light of Revelation for the Nations" so it is the custom to bless candles on this feast to signify Christ as the light of the world. This occurs at the beginning of the Mass in the vestibule and then we process into the Church to begin Mass.

Following Mass, blessed candles will be available to take home to use for private devotions and for when the Blessed Sacrament is brought home for the sick.

I hope you will join us on Friday, February 2nd at 7:30 in the evening as we celebrate this beautiful feast

Please keep me in your prayers and know that you are remembered each day at the Altar.
