RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:

Registration for Religious Education for 2023-2024 is now open. Please go to the Basilica website (Stjohnbasilica.org) to complete the online registration form and payment. Payment is due at time of registration. *Please note:* Registration prices will increase \$25 on Monday, August 28th.

The first day of classes is Sunday, September 24th. For Grades 1 - 7, classes will be held on Sunday mornings in Nagle Hall from 8:30-9:45 AM. Confirmation classes, offered for students entering Grade 8 and up, will be held on Sunday evenings (twice a month) from 5:30-7:00 PM. The full schedule will be available in hard copy on the first day of class or on the parish website mid-August.

IMPORTANT (for new students only): Please submit copies of your child's Baptism Certificate and/or First Communion Certificate (if the sacrament did not take place at St. John's).

Gentle reminder: Sunday Mass attendance is required for all Religious Education students. Classes are scheduled around our Mass times for convenience.
