

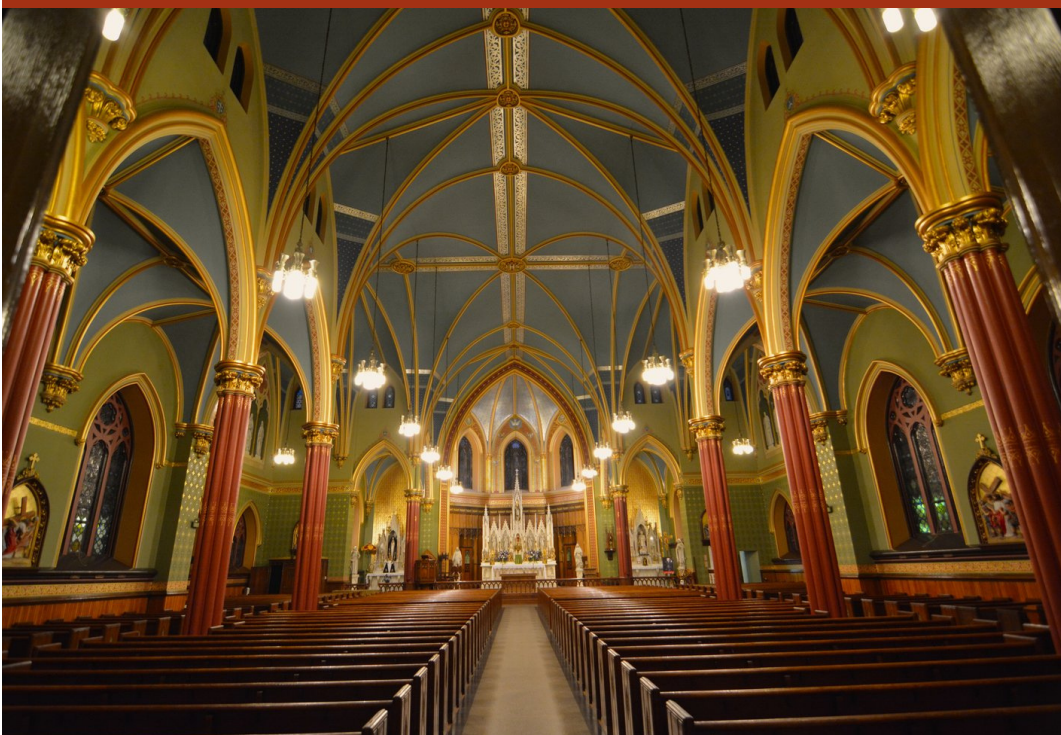

Wine is traditionally blessed on the Feast of Saint John in remembrance of the legend that Saint John safely drank poisoned wine offered to him by his enemy after blessing it.



TE DEUM AND BENEDICTION

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 31ST AT 7:00 PM

There are many traditions associated with this time of the year. One of the lesser known is the singing of the “Te Deum” a hymn of thanksgiving sung for special occasions. It is the custom to sing the “Te Deum” on New Year’s Eve to offer thanks to God for the graces given during the previous year.

The Church offers a plenary indulgence to those who participate in this devotion under the usual conditions. (Sacramental Confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father within 8 days of the devotion.)

This year our choir will sing the “Te Deum” followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00pm on New Year’s Eve.

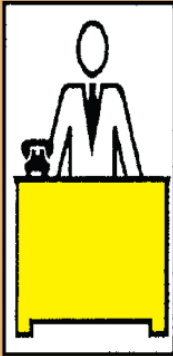
