YOUNG ADULTS GROUP



^{*}Depreciation expense accounting was implemented for fiscal year 2022, as per Diocesan mandate, resulting in a one-time charge of prior years' cumulative depreciation of \$5,484,862 against Net Assets as of June 30, 2021. In fiscal year 2022, depreciation expense of \$466,244 was recorded, resulting in a negative Change of Net Assets of (\$365,945). Without the depreciation, change of net assets would be \$100,299. Going forward, annual depreciation will now be reflected in all future years.
